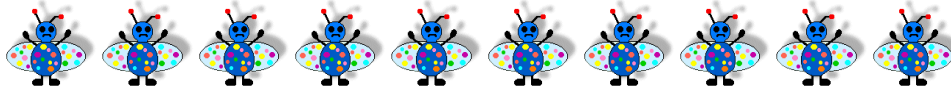




Health Room Visits



Students will be given temporary care in case of illness/injury during school hours. If your child has a medical condition, it is essential that the school be informed **immediately**. We must also have correct current work, home or cell phone number for each student's parent/guardian. Please complete a new health card each school year and notify the school immediately if this information changes during the year. It is also important that we have an emergency number (neighbor, friend, relative) on file at school in case the parent or guardian can not be reached.



To ensure the protection of all children, any student exhibiting the following symptoms must be sent home:

- Temperature of 100.4 degrees or above
- An undetermined rash
- Nausea/vomiting or diarrhea
- Red, draining eyes
- Open draining lesions
- Active head lice
- Communicable diseases listed by the Texas State Department of Health
- If the severity of the condition indicates school attendance would not be in the best interest of the child

It is recommended that the child be “fever free” for 24 hours BEFORE returning to school

Please check with the nurse if you have any doubts. Readmission to school is permitted when the student has recovered or a written medical release is submitted to the school.

The district is not responsible for any costs incurred for medical or dental care, or for emergency transportation. However, if you are unable to afford medical care, dental care, eye care, or medications please talk to your school nurse. There are organizations within our community that may be able to help.
